The goal of AOK is to strengthen the family unit; assist children to develop to their fullest potential; to deliver a positive program in a safe, supportive, educational, caring environment; and to assist children to accept and demonstrate the values of caring, honesty, responsibility and respect.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ▶ Summer Camp opens at **7am** (not before). **Do not** leave a child unattended before **7am**.
- ▶ Children must be picked up by **5:30pm**. A late fee of \$5 for **every 5 minutes** late after **5:30pm** will be charged. If a parent/guardian does not sign a child out, a full-day tuition fee will be applied.
- ▶ All children must attend scheduled activities, but participation is determined by the parent/guardian.
- ▶ Names must be marked on all personal items. AOK is **NOT** responsible for lost, broken or stolen items.
- ▶ Campers **MUST** be enrolled in 2018–2019 Kindergarten to attend.

TUITION & FEES

- ▶ Enrollment fees are \$13/day or \$10/half day (4 hours or less).
- ▶ A \$100 non-refundable activity fee is due at time of registration.
- ▶ Tuition must be paid in full, in advance, weekly. A child may be dismissed from the program if payment is delinquent. AOK **WILL NOT** carry a balance and payment for the week will be due Monday morning.
- ▶ The LAST week of camp must be paid in advance. If an account carries a credit that balance may roll over to after school or a check will be mailed; parent/guardian's choice.
- ▶ State subsidies are welcome but not determined by AOK.
- ▶ Make checks out to AOK and put your child's first and last name in the memo.
- ▶ Credit/debit card information will be kept on file and processed on Mondays unless notified in advance.
- ▶ Parent/guardian is responsible for purchasing Lamar Swim Park swimming pass or sending \$3 on pool day.
- ▶ Tuition statements will be emailed weekly. Paper copies may be requested.

SNACKS & MEALS

- ▶ Breakfast is served at **8:30am**, lunch at noon and snack at **3:45pm**.
- ▶ **All meals are free** and are not calculated into daily fees. Participants may bring a water bottle or lunch or snack of their own.

DRESS CODE

- ▶ Tennis shoes are the best choice for daily activities. Sandals or flip flops are discouraged.
- ▶ Females must wear a one-piece swim suit or a colored t-shirt cover up.
- ▶ Shorts/skirts must reach the bottom of finger tips when hands are held straight down to the side.
- ▶ Tops must cover the belly button and be at least **1"** across at the top of shoulder (no strapless, no ties).
- ▶ No clothing featuring profanity, tobacco, alcohol or drugs may be worn.

The Director will determine appropriate dress. Participants may be required to change clothing and/or leave.

DISCIPLINE

Appropriate positive language and behavior are expected at AOK programs. AOK discipline includes time-out, positive reinforcement and withholding fun activities. Written behavior and accident report forms are available up on request. AOK reserves the right to dismiss any child from any AOK program at any time.

AOK reserves the right to contact school personnel and/or appropriate professionals when there is a negative behavior pattern or serious incident/offense.

RELEASE OF PARTICIPANTS

All children must be signed in and signed out each day. Only persons designated by parent/guardian on the enrollment form will be allowed to pick up a child at a scheduled activity. The group leader may ask for identification if they don't know the person or if the child acts suspiciously. **If there a legal document or custody order in place for your child, AOK must have a copy on file. Otherwise, parents/guardians have the right to pick up their child.**

IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW, PARENTS/GUARDIANS OF PARTICIPANTS ARE WELCOME TO VISIT, ANNOUNCED OR UNANNOUNCED, EXCEPT WHEN A COURT ORDER OR DECREE THAT SPECIFIES DIFFERENTLY. (COPY MUST BE ON FILE WITH AOK)

TRANSPORTATION

Participants enrolled in AOK programs may be transported by bus or approved staff vehicle to and from Summer School and AOK activities only. Campers and VolunTeens may ride bicycles to any AOK activities as long as they are accompanied by AOK staff. AOK is not responsible for transporting a child to and from home for any reason.

If items are forgotten for swimming or other activities, AOK staff will not be responsible for taking the child to retrieve forgotten items. The child will participate in alternative activities that day, unless parent/guardian brings items to the center. *(This includes VolunTeens)*

MEDICATIONS

A child may not receive medication of any type from AOK staff unless required by a doctor to be given on a scheduled basis. Parents/guardians must fill out a medical authorization form with child's name, reason for medication, dosage and frequency. Medication must be provided in original container with pharmacy/doctor instructions and label. Unused medication must be taken home at the end of the prescription period.

ILLNESS

Please inform the Director if your child develops a contagious disease. Children having a fever of 100 degrees or more or suspected of being ill will be separated from the other children and the parent/guardian or emergency contact will be contacted immediately.

LEAVING THE PREMISES

If a child or VolunTeen leaves the premises for any reason without prior approval from staff or parents/guardians, the child will not be allowed to return to camp on that day. Parents/guardians will be contacted and the child will be required to have an absence slip signed by parent/guardian in order to return.

RELEASE OF INFORMATION

AOK is allowed to share programming information with Lamar School District and the Lamar School District is allowed to share programming information with AOK.

VIPs (VOLUNTEENS IN PROGRESS)

For 2018 summer campers going into 6th grade this fall

WHAT ARE VOLUNTEENS?

AOK offers an innovative youth program known as the VolunTeens for kids in grades 6-8. Youth are exposed to the importance of volunteering in the community all while giving our area youth a safe, drug and alcohol-free place to have fun with educational, fun, enrichment activities that cover such things as job training, computer technology, nutrition and fitness.

WHAT ARE VIPs?

The VolunTeens in Progress (VIPs) Program is offered during Summer Camp for kids who will be going into 6th grade in the fall. Children this age are still considered “campers” but they are given the opportunity to become acclimated to the middle school atmosphere at Nathan’s Place including the increased independence and responsibility.

VIPs spend one morning a week at Nathan’s Place where they have a class on careers or nutrition and a service learning project, such as delivering Meals on Wheels. After lunch they attend the Plaza Theatre with the VolunTeens and then return to the Wolf Center for the remainder of the afternoon. VIPs have their own Summer Camp group leader and help out with younger kids.

WHEN?

Wednesdays of Summer Camp, May 21–August 14, approximately **10:00am–3:30pm**

WHERE?

Continue to pick up and drop off at the Wolf Center, 801 E. 12th Street.

COST?

The VIP program has no additional costs above the standard Summer Camp tuition. Snack money for activities is optional.

THE RULES

Participants in the VIP program will be expected to follow all rules pertaining to AOK campers and VolunTeens.
